Keynote Speaker: Ramona Trevino



Ramona is a living testament to the power of prayer and the witness of public faith. Her transformation from someone who fought for abortion to an individual who is now a warrior in the pro-

life movement is proof that the struggle is a winnable one. For three years, Ramona worked as the manager of a Planned Parenthood abortion-referral facility in Sherman, Texas. In the spring of 2011, thanks to the inspiration from a local Christian radio station, the prayers and public witness of a 40 Days for Life campaign, and through God's grace, Ramona reclaimed her walk with Christ and resigned her position at Planned Parenthood, which resulted in the clinic closing.

Ramona is now sharing the story of her pro-life conversion and resulting departure from the organization responsible for the most abortions in the United States.

A native of Trenton, Texas, a small town northeast of Dallas, Ramona is married to a godly man, and they have six children.

Following Ramona's talk, "Silent No More Awareness" members will provide testimonies and we will conclude with The Prayer Walk for Life to RETA and the Women's Care Center.

Over 500 Babies Saved From Abortion After Doctors Reverse the Abortion Pill



For more than a decade, women have used Abortion Pill Reversal as a means to stop their in-progress chemical abortions and save their unborn babies' lives.

Now, Heartbeat International, which took the reins of this 24-7 helpline and provider network this spring, says the protocol has led to the births of more than 500 babies, with another 100 on the way.
